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Reid Golf Course COVID-19 Policies and Reminders for 2021

Reid's number one priority is the safety of patrons and staff alike and we will strictly adhere to these policies. Additionally this global pandemic continues to be a fluid situation and these procedures can change without notice, thank you for your cooperation.

- 1. If yourself, a member of your immediate family or someone you have come in contact with is sick, please stay home and self-quarantine.
- 2. Physically distance yourself from others by keeping a minimum of 6' of space between yourself and others or utilize face coverings when it is not possible.
- 3. Reduce how often you touch public items and your face. When you do come in contact with a public item wash or sanitize your hands. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the clubhouse for your use.
- 4. Follow the procedures and posted signage to keep yourself and others safe during this time.

Reid is taking the following steps during this time to limit exposure for golfers and staff:

- Increased sanitization:
 - Counters, handles, knobs, credit card readers, restrooms, carts, range ball baskets and all other touch points will be sanitized with CDC approved disinfectants multiple times per day.
- Reduced touch points for the golfer:
 - Condiments, napkins and other miscellaneous food supplies will be kept behind the counter, please ask for what you need while ordering.
 - The drinking fountains on the golf course will remain off, inside the clubhouse they will be operational and sanitized routinely, water is available for purchase in the pro shop.

Reid Operating Procedures:

- Face coverings will be required inside the clubhouse at all times, exception while eating and drinking in designated area, face coverings will be provided for those who need one at the entry door.
- Limit of 2 people in pro shop at a time for check in. Keep 6' minimum from others, please do not wait in the pro shop, check in and vacate to the first tee or range through side door (follow signage).

- Indoor dining is available* with reduced capacity, face coverings may be removed while eating and drinking. **Kitchen closed opening weekend**
- Range use will be limited to 7 golfers at a time. Please hit within ropes and markers signifying physically distant hitting stations.
- Pins may be removed while putting, ballwashers and divot mix containers will be on the course to begin the season.
- Power cart rentals will be double rider, Reid recommends the use of face coverings when riding with someone from another household. Face coverings will be provided for those who need one at the entry door.
- Power and pull carts will be sanitized between uses. Power carts are rented on a first come first serve basis, therefore, power carts will not be issued until 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tee time.
